



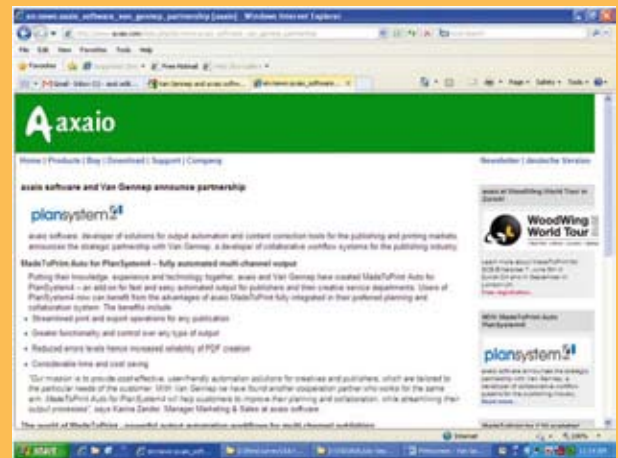
Van Genneq and axaio software announce partnership

The apps may be stored on the Apple iTunes store from where they may be downloaded by the reader who is then able to make their content purchase by one click within the app, and pay via the iTunes micro payment system. The financial model for providing the reader with the app and the content is a decision made by the publisher, independently of ProImage.

Equinox software may be implemented in-house, or used cost-effectively as a hosted SaaS (software as a service) solution.
